

# 2022 ePoster Research Abstract Guidelines

# ALL POSTERS ARE PRESENTED ELECTRONICALLY.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Abstracts will be listed in the ACVIM Forum Program.
- ePosters are provided digitally for conference attendees to access through a virtual gallery.
- ePosters provide viewers high-quality resolution of images and text. Like traditional posters, ePosters provide a concise snapshot of your work. But instead of a physical poster pinned to a board, ePosters are a single slide presentation which is viewed on a computer.
- ePosters add additional viewing options and extend the life cycle of the ePoster.
- ePosters will be uploaded to a secure website and available for viewing throughout the Live Virtual and On Demand meeting.
- There will be awards for best resident research presentations by eligible ACVIM Candidates. Winners will be announced Friday, June 24, at the ACVIM Awards Luncheon. Winners will be contacted through email morning of Friday, June 24 to alert them.


#### **ePOSTER REPARATION**

- Prepare your ePoster as an electronic facsimile replicating what a physical poster would look like.
- No animations, video or audio are permitted.
- You will prepare your ePoster using MS PowerPoint<sup>™</sup>. Your ePoster will be created on a single slide (ONE).
- You MUST use an ACVIM Forum ePoster template. Templates found online in the ACVIM Forum Speaker Resource Center.
- Prepare a label for the top of the ePoster indicating the title, the authors, and the institutional affiliation.
- You **MUST** include a Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement. Refer to the Speaker Disclosure Slide from a Presentation Template found online in the ACVIM Forum Speaker Resource Center for a sample format to use.
- If you have nothing to disclose, please state this.
- You may also use the Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement for acknowledgments, or prior presentation, if needed.
- A brief but clearly worded "Introduction" as well as "Summary and Conclusions" are key features for understanding the data presented.
- Text and legends for figures should be short, but <u>do not</u> omit them. Make sure to use <u>large</u>, clear, easy-to-read print for text and legends.
- The use of color adds emphasis and draws interest to the presentation; however, limited use of green and red is encouraged.

#### UPLOAD

- You will submit your ePoster electronically as a PDF into the Upload Center through your Poster Presenter Portal.
- o All submitted ePosters will be transferred to our online gallery for presentation.
- Deadline: Monday, June 13.
