



# Clean, Safe and Hospitality Services

Founded by DSA in 1999, the Metropolitan Improvement District is a business-improvement area spanning 300 square blocks in downtown. Funding from property owners within the MID boundaries provides cleaning, safety and hospitality services, as well as oversight and activation of multiple urban parks and public spaces. MID-funded ambassadors are on the streets of downtown 362 days a year, ensuring a clean, safe and welcoming experience for everyone. The MID includes six downtown neighborhoods: Belltown, Denny Triangle, Pioneer Square, Retail Core, Waterfront and West Edge.
