The courses I have taken have included Physiology (Guyton and Hall Textbook of Medical Physiology), Advanced Clinical Pathology (Stockham and Scott's Fundamentals of Veterinary Clinical Pathology), Advanced Equine Diseases GI, Renal, and currently Neuromuscular. Advanced Equine Diseases are taught by LAIM clinicians.
